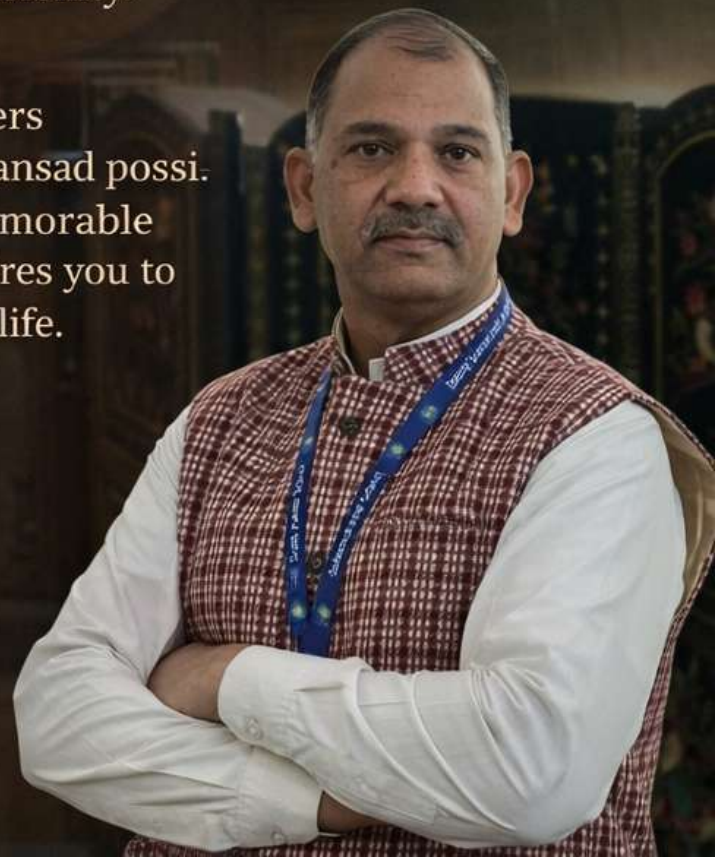

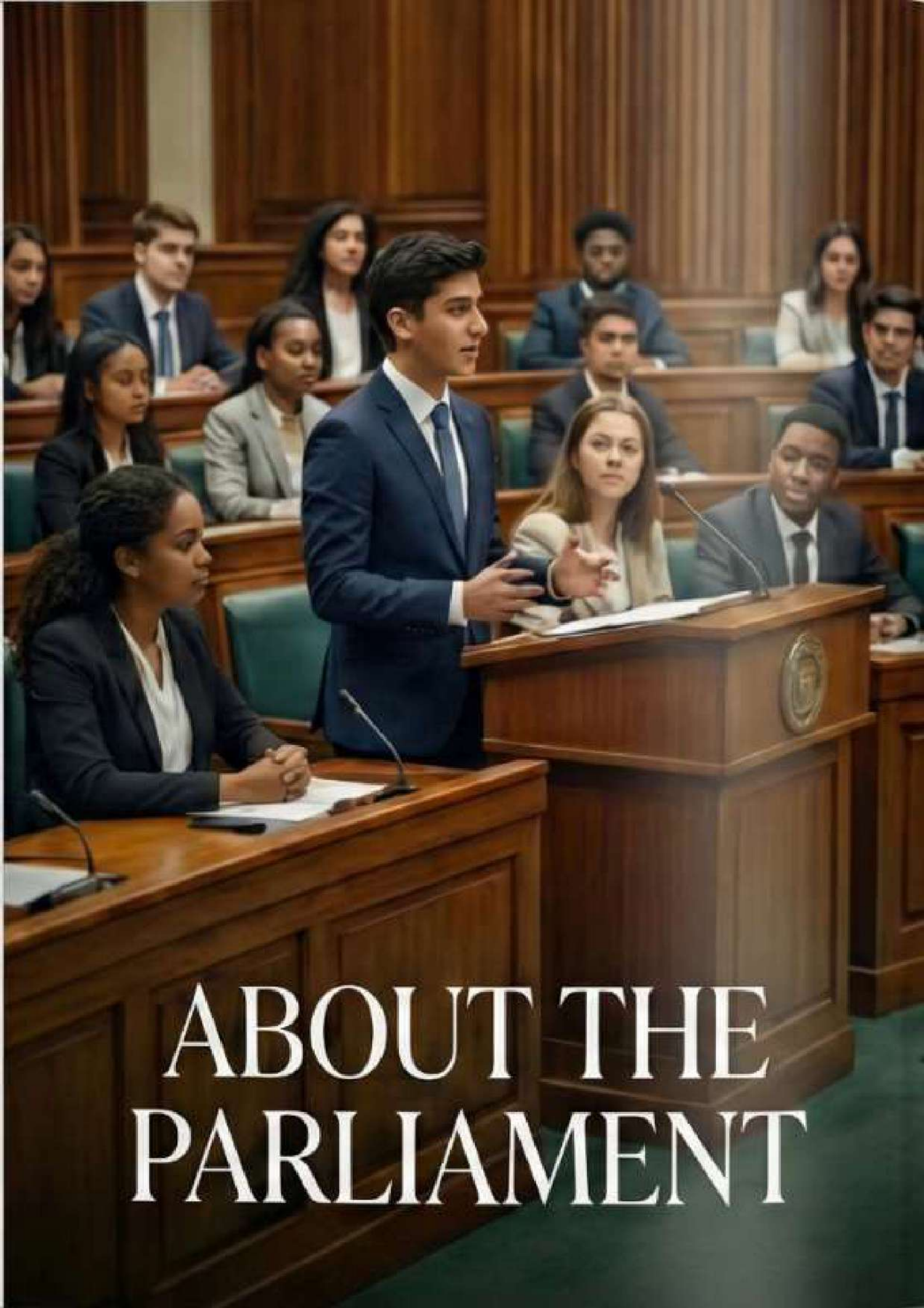

- Maintain discipline and adhere to the event guidelines.



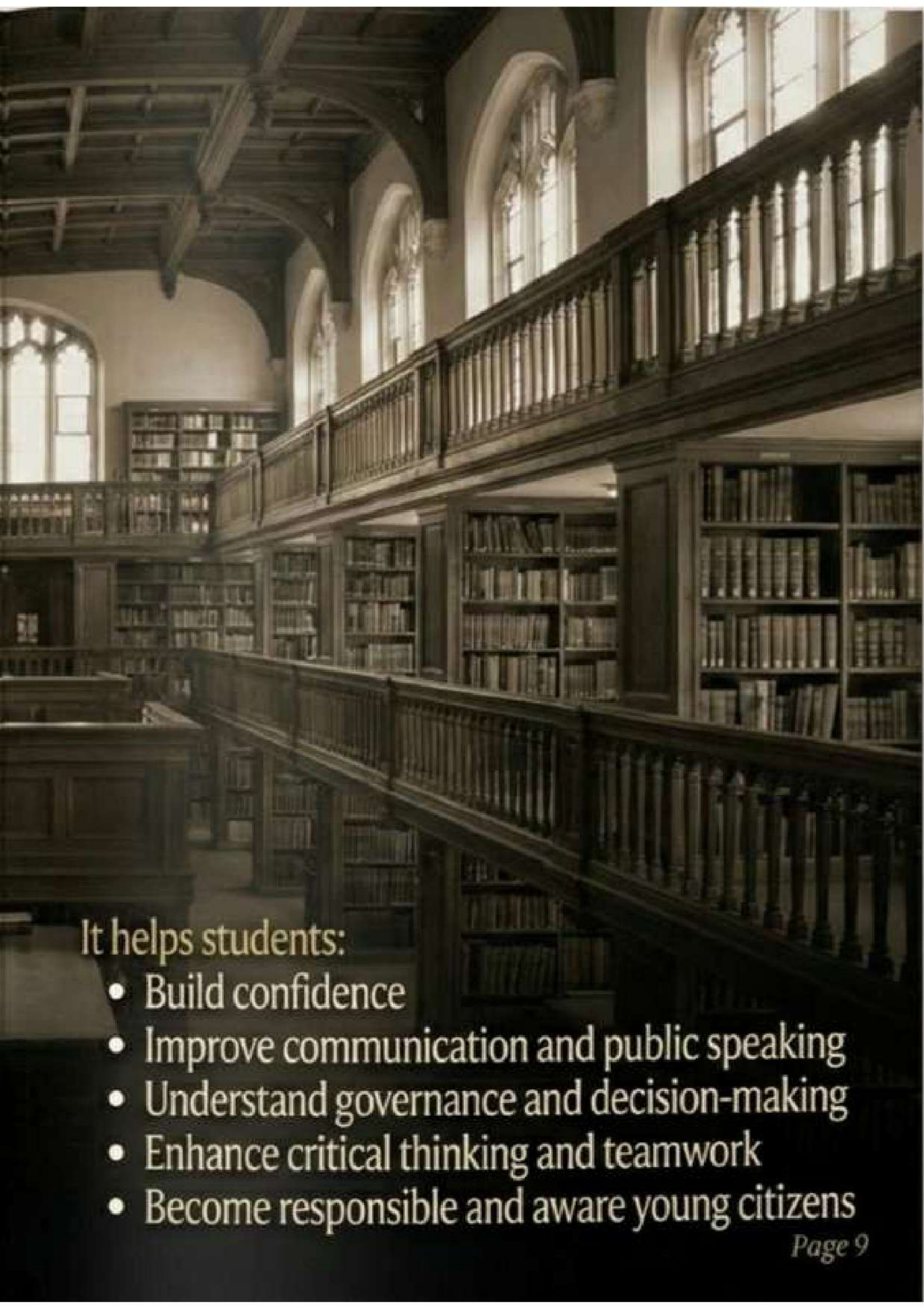




# WHY YOU SHOULD PARTICIPATE
